



Kilimanjaro, the highest mountain in Africa and fourth highest of the Seven Summits, is considered the tallest freestanding mountain in the world, rising 15,100 feet (4,600 meters) from base to summit. Kilimanjaro is also the most prominent mountain in Africa. Kilimanjaro first climb by the German geology professor Hans Meyer, Yoanas Kinyala Lauwo (Tanzania), and Ludwig Purtscheller (Austria) on October 5, 1889.

Kilimanjaro is composed of three distinct volcanic cones: Kibo 19,340 feet (5,895 meters); Mawenzi 16,896 feet (5,149 meters); and Shira 13,000 feet (3,962 meters). Uhuru Peak is the highest summit on Kibo's crater rim.

Machame Route is the most beautiful route up

Kilimanjaro (also called as the "Whiskey route"). Climbing Kilimanjaro requires no technical climbing or mountaineering experience. It is just a long trek from base to summit. Some parts of the mountain require basic scrambling skills (i.e. the Barranco Wall) but in general, anyone with decent fitness can climb.

Day wise Itinerary

Day 1: Moshi

Arrive at Kilimanjaro airport pick up and transfer to the Springlands Hotel at Moshi or similar for O/N stay.

Day 2: Machame Gate - Machame Camp

Elevation: 1743m - 3026m, Distance: 18 km, Trek Time: 5-7 hrs

After breakfast, Drive Moshi to Mount Kilimanjaro National Park Gate (Machame Gate) through the village of Machame. Start your trek through the rain forest till we reach Machame Camp. O/N at the camp.

Day 3: Shira Camp

Elevation: 3026m - 3766m, Distance: 9 km, Trek Time: 4-6 hrs

We continue climbing, crossing the little valley walking along a steep rocky ridge. O/N at Shira campsite.

Day 4: Lava Tower - Barranco Camp

Elevation: 3766m - 3983m, Distance: 15 km, Trek Time: 6-8 hrs

From the Shira Plateau, we continue the trek to the junction towards the peak of Kibo. As we continue direction changes to the South East towards the Lava Tower, called the "Shark's Tooth." We now continue down to the Barranco Hut. Although you end the day at the same elevation as when you started, this day is very important for acclimatization and will help your body prepare for summit day.



Day 5: Barafu Camp

Elevation: 3983m - 4645m, Distance: 13 km, Trek Time: 8 hrs

We leave Barranco and continue on a steep ridge passing the Barranco Wall, to the Karanga Valley campsite. We continue up to the Barafu Hut. The two peaks of Mawenzi and Kibo are to be seen from this position.

Day 6: Summit Day: Uhuru Peak (5,895m) - Mweka Camp

Elevation: 4645m - 5895m (and down to 3110m), Distance: 5 km ascent / 12 km descent, Trek Time: 7-8 hrs ascent / 6-7 hrs descent



Very early in the morning (midnight to 2am), we continue our way to the summit between the Rebmann and Ratzel glaciers. You will get to witness the most magnificent sunrise at this point. From Stella Point, you may encounter snow all the way till the summit. Uhuru peak is the highest point on Mount Kilimanjaro and the continent of Africa. From the summit, we now make our descent continuing straight down to the Mweka camp site.

Day 7: Mweka Camp - Mweka Gate - Moshi

Elevation: 3110m - 1743m, Distance: 10 km, Trek Time: 3-4 hrs

We descent down along the same path and reach the National Park Gates. We then drive back to Moshi for O/N stay.

Day 8: Transfer to Kilimanjaro airport for a flight back home

Cost Includes

- Transport from Moshi to starting point on mountain and return to Moshi
- Hut / camping fees and tents
- Certified, experienced, English-speaking guides for all routes
- Porters' salaries
- Rescue fees (required by the national park)
- All meals on the mountain

- Tents, foam sleeping pads, cooking equipment, and eating utensils
- Oximeters are available upon request

Cost Excludes

- International airfare to and from Kilimanjaro
- Kilimanjaro Visa fees
- Excess baggage charges
- Extra night accommodation in Kilimanjaro because of early arrival, late departure, and early return from the mountain (due to any reason) than the scheduled itinerary
- Travel and rescue insurance
- Personal expenses (phone calls, laundry, bar bills, battery recharge, extra porters, bottle or boiled water, shower etc)
- Mountain equipment (e.g. sleeping bags)
- Food at the Moshi, Springlands Hotel
